#### **Cleansing Notice / Appendix 2A**

#### Issue of Shares - Notice pursuant to Section 708A(5)(e) of the Corporations Act 2001

Los Cerros Limited (ASX: LCL) ("Los Cerros" or the "Company") advises that it has issued and allotted 420,017 fully paid ordinary shares ("Shares") upon the exercise of 200,000 unquoted options exercisable at \$0.07 per option on or before 1 July 2025, the exercise of 125,000 unquoted options exercisable at \$0.10 per option on or before 6 April 2022, the exercise of 62,500 unquoted options exercisable at \$0.02 per option on or before 18 May 2022, and the exercise of 32,517 quoted options exercisable at \$0.16 per option on or before 16 August 2021.
